Liquid Waste Management

IIBS is equipped with Sewage Treatment Plant to process the liquid waste and use the recycled water for the gardening.

Sewage treatment involves multiple treatments. It has three wells in which the first well collects the sewage water and processed to the rectors. And finally, the processed water is collected into the third well and used for watering plants.

Flotation reactor: Flotation is known as a separation process, based on the introduction of gas bubbles as the transport medium. Suspended particulate matter, being hydrophobic or



conditioned to be so, is then attach to the bubbles and moves toward the water solution surface—i.e., contrary to the direction of gravity

Carbon Filter: Activated Carbon Filter is used to adsorb chlorine, organics, tri-halo methane (THM), taste, odour, and colour from Water & Wastewater. Activated carbon is a charcoal that has been treated with oxygen to open up millions of tiny pores between the carbon atoms.


Sand Filter: Sand filters produce high-quality water without the use of chemical aids. Passing flocculated water through a rapid gravity sand filter strains out the floc and the particles trapped within it, reducing numbers of bacteria and removing most of the solids.

The finally treated water is used for watering the plants

- College works towards generating minimal e-waste by reusing it. Regular maintenance of
 electronic equipment and computers ensures longer life. E-waste bin is provided for the
 collection of the e-waste generated in college campus, which is given to the authorized
 agency for recycling and disposal.



The source of water to the campus is through borewell. The excess amount of the water harvested from the rain water harvesting is pumped out to recharge the ground water aquifers.









