E-Governance Policy

Policy:

The institute will implement e-governance in all significant areas such as library, accounts, admissions, administration, teaching and evaluation etc. The policy is designed and framed to make each and every function efficient, effective, transparent and accountable.

Procedures:

College Website: The institutional website will act as an information dissemination centerabout the college, courses offered, notices and circulars, information about various events organized and going to be organized, other university correspondences etc. For this purpose, a separate service provider/web designer was appointed by the institute. Training is given to the concerned in charges to make important updates available on the institution's website. A Website Committee is formed for the administration of the college website. The Committee will look after the process of updating, maintaining and working of the website on a regular

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basis. The Committee will also look after the other changes that are required in the website. All the important notifications will go live on the website and also the information about happened events and activities will be posted on the institution's website

Admissions: Transparent procedure for the admission process is followed and implemented as per the regulations of Bangalore city University. The College brings out its Prospectus which is displayed on the institution's website that has guidelines for the admission process. A devoted admissions tab is used to manage the admissions in the college. Detailed stages involved in applying to the course, number of students applying to each course, fee submission, all will be managed through the institute's portal. Students are required to submit a separate Online Application Form for taking admission to the college and for this purpose an onlinesoftware to be used by the institute.

Accounting: International Institute of Business Studies (IIBS) has introduced an upgraded version of TALLY to manage Finance and Accounts operations. The accounting module enables and support tasks which are taken on day-to-day basis. This software enables faster access to the reports and has enhanced security.

Administrative Software: Dhi is the Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) Software used in the college for correspondence and communication, internal examinations, internal marks posting, classroom activities and Learning Platforms. The system has come up with much functionality for the institution to track and check the internal grade of students and also it reduces the efforts of entering marks manually by the faculty. The software enables teaching learning processes efficient and effective.

Library: International Institute of Business Studies (IIBS) library is automated from 2016 using Integrated Library Management System with the support of Easylib Cloud version. LAN and Wi-Fi connections in the library provides easy access to learning resources. E-resources can be accessed through J Gate, Ebsco, Proquest, Delnet, and National Digital Library of India(NDLI)-a customized interface designed for the institution makes it possible for students and faculty to access all digital resources at any time, from the water and on any device. Web OPAC (Online

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Public Access Catalogue) is available for easy access of the online resources. Its link is added to the institutional website.

Waste Management: International Institute of Business Studies implemented waste management system by dumping all food waste into pits created separately. The waste dumped into it is used as fertilizer for farming inside the campus.
